**Dexter, MI, June 20, 2008**—The Tax & Accounting business of Thomson Reuters, formerly Thomson Tax & Accounting, announced today that its leading tax preparation software, UltraTax CS, was ranked first with the IRS for federal 1040 electronic filing acceptance. Listed on the IRS's 2007 *Software Error Reject Code Report*, UltraTax CS earned a 96.34% acceptance rate—the highest in the industry.
