Thomson Reuters Named a 2010 Top Workplace by The Detroit Free Press

Tax & Accounting Business of Thomson Reuters is Recognized Again as a Great Place to Work

Dexter/Ann Arbor, MI, December 9, 2010—The Tax & Accounting business of Thomson Reuters has once again been recognized as an outstanding place to work. This past November, *The Detroit Free Press* honored 105 companies as “Top Workplaces” in Michigan. The Tax & Accounting business of Thomson Reuters (three Michigan locations) placed #17 on the Top Workplaces list in the large company category. This accomplishment adds to Thomson Reuters’ 2009 designation as a “Cool Place to Work in Tough Times” by *Crain’s Detroit Business Magazine*.

The survey was open to all businesses and organizations with at least 50 employees, and businesses were ranked in three categories: small, medium, and large. Thomson Reuters employs 894 people in its Dexter and Ann Arbor offices. Workplace Dynamics of Exton, PA, which designs and conducts workplace surveys, evaluated responses from 202 companies that employ a total of more than 130,000 Michigan workers.

Associate Sales Manager, April White, located in the Dexter office, said, “As part of Thomson Reuters, you *want* to work harder, stand out, and make a difference. And the company rewards us with outings like baseball games, family carnivals, picnics, team events, and charity drives—they’re all about making employees happy. They continue to understand the need for work/life balance, and as a result, we’re better at our jobs knowing we can enjoy our time outside of work without guilt. The survey company gathered and analyzed responses from 41,291 employees across the state and concluded that top employers focused on staff satisfaction. The survey also found that what distinguishes the best workplaces from the others is not pay and benefits. Workers really value employers that are going in the right direction, have strong leaders, are doing things ethically, and know how to make workers feel appreciated.

“We’re honored to be included on the list. And it’s even more prestigious because our own employees put us there. We have a lot of talent at Thomson Reuters and our employees work hard, so it’s important to the executive team in Michigan to acknowledge that effort.
