When you join an ideas community, we ask that you include your first name and your firm name in your profile. After your membership is approved, we ask that you do the following.

- Add ideas and suggestions.
- Comment on ideas and suggestions that were added by other users.
- Agree with ideas and suggestions that are important to your firm.
- Build a consensus in the community by making your case for why an idea or suggestion will be helpful.
- Avoid entering duplicate ideas and suggestions. If you notice duplicate ideas or suggestions, please flag them as duplicates so that we can consolidate them.
- Flag ideas and suggestions that don't meet the Code of Conduct. (The Code of Conduct is part of the Guidelines & Terms of Use, which you can access through the link at the top of the Ideas Community Welcome screen.)
