

2018 ULTRATAX/1065 PROFORMA & BUSINESS ORGANIZER, v.2018.1.0 User Bulletin 1065US-18.1.0: Initial Release

November 19, 2018

This release contains a fully functional federal 1065 application, which is used to proform client data and produce Business Organizers.

Many of the forms included in this release are preliminary or prior-year versions and are subject to change. As a result, final testing of all federal calculations has not been completed. Therefore, we recommend that, beyond proforma processing and producing Business Organizers, you do not use this release to prepare your returns. The December release will include fully tested calculations for any government forms received.

PROFORMA

Client documents

Due to changes to add tax due and overpayment remittance sections, to remove references to Form 1065-B, to replace tax matters partner (TMP) with partnership representative (PR), and to modify the signature sections for changes in partnership return signature requirements, proforma of the following client documents is not available.

Due to tax law changes, the following client documents are no longer applicable and proforma of them has been removed.

- 1065 Consolidated Audit Rule Election

Form 1065-B

Public Law 114-74, Title XI, section 1101(b), repealed the electing large partnership rules for partnership tax years beginning after 2017. Form 1065-B and its related forms and schedules are obsolete and have been removed from the application. Any clients that filed Form 1065-B in 2017 will automatically be changed to file Form 1065 during proforma.

Schedule K depreciation

The Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA) suspended miscellaneous itemized deductions subject to 2% limitation, including some portfolio deductions. In prior years, UltraTax CS classified expenses related to portfolio assets (depreciation, amortization, start-up expenses, organization costs, and lease inclusions) as portfolio deductions subject to the 2% limitation. To aid in calculating state conformity differences, the *Treat Schedule K depreciation as portfolio deductions (other)* field has been added to Screen CltOptns. When marked, these expenses will be classified as Portfolio deductions (other) and included in Schedule K, line 13, Other deductions. When blank, these expenses will not be included in the federal return; however, the amounts will be available for state calculations.

UltraTax/1065 can mark the option in Screen CltOptns automatically. The option is marked differently depending on whether the client is an existing client being proforma'd from the prior year or a new client subsequently added to the application.

 Existing clients being proforma'd: Select the Treat Schedule K depreciation as portfolio deductions option in the Setup > 1065 Partnership > Other Return Options > Proforma tab.

Note: The option on Screen CltOptns marks during client proforma. Therefore, the option on the Proforma tab in Other Return Options dialog must be marked before you proforma the client.

 New clients subsequently added: Select the Treat Schedule K depreciation as portfolio deductions option in the Setup >1065 Partnership > New Client Options > Return Presentation tab.

Print collations

We recommend you do not customize or proforma form print collations with this release. The December release of UltraTax/1065 will include changes for released government forms, which may cause UltraTax CS to override any form print collation customizations you complete with this release.

State data

When you receive and install your state applications on a later release, UltraTax CS will automatically proforma the prior-year UltraTax/1065 state data as you process returns for each client.

BUSINESS ORGANIZER

This release of UltraTax/1065 includes the <u>Business Organizer</u>, a powerful feature that allows you to create and send professional Business Organizer packages to your clients. The Business Organizer includes both a questionnaire and a Microsoft® Excel® spreadsheet.

The following changes were made to the 2018 UltraTax/1065 Business Organizer Questionnaire.

- Questions referring to tax matters partner were changed to partnership representative.
- Questions were added to ask if any foreign individual, entity, or trust partners exist and whether any withholding was made for the partners.

CHANGES

This release includes the following changes in reaction to the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA).

- Added Nondeductible entertainment and Nondeductible expenses subject to 2% fields on Screen M1M2 in the Balance Sheet folder.
- Added Entertainment and Nondeductible expenses subject to 2% fields to Screen M3-3 in the Balance Sheet folder.
- Added Screen QBI in the Income & Deductions, Farm, Farm Rent, and Rent folders to calculate the Partner's Section 199A Information Worksheet.
- Added Screen 965 in the Schedule K folder.

This release includes the following changes from the prior year version of UltraTax/1065.

- IRS Service center for paper filed partnership returns has changed for the following states.
 - Partnerships located in Connecticut, Delaware, District of Columbia, Indiana, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, Vermont, Virginia, and West Virginia are filed in Kansas City, MO if the total assets at the end of the year are less than \$10 million and Schedule M-3 is not filed.
 - Partnerships located in Florida are filed in Ogden, UT.
- Tax Matters Partner (TMP) has changed to Partnership Representative (PR). Additionally, if the Partnership Representative is not an individual, a Partnership Representative Designated Individual (PRDI) should be entered. Both the PR and PRDI, if applicable, must have a US address. Data entry on Screen Contact in the General folder and on the Partner tab in View > Partner Information has changed accordingly.
- The name of the person signing the return and the name of the partnership representative designated individual both changed from one 35-wide name field to separate first name and last name fields, 14-wide and 20-wide respectively. Data entered in the prior year fields will proform to the new separate fields. Review proforma'd data on Screen Contact in the General folder.
- The Extension and Late Filing Penalty sections, formerly on Screen 1065, have moved to new Screen Pmt in the Payments folder.
- Added fields to Screens K and K1 for dividend equivalents not included in ordinary dividends.
- Personal use rental expense reported on schedule M-1/M-3 does not include personal use portion of tax credit adjustments.
